

AMO is a component of CBP, with approximately 1,800 federal agents and mission support personnel conducting its mission in the air and maritime environments at and beyond the border, and within the nation's interior. We operate throughout the United States, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

FY22 Results:

- · 250,616 lbs of cocaine
- 104,262 lbs of marijuana
- · 25,625 lbs of methamphetamine
- 1,475 lbs of fentanyl
- 1,342 weapons and \$21.7 million
- 967 arrests
- 134,981 apprehensions of undocumented immigrants

How We Do It:

We pilot 240 airplanes, helicopters, and unmanned aircraft, command 300 marine vessels, and operate surveillance systems to detect, interdict, and prevent acts of terrorism and the unlawful movement of people, illicit drugs, and other contraband into the U.S. by air, land, and sea.
