

Updates to ACE Drawback Module for Petroleum Superfund Taxes (CBP-164)

Last updated: August 8, 2024



On **September 17, 2024**, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) will add a new accounting class code (CC) in the Automated Commercial Environment (ACE) to facilitate drawback of Petroleum Superfund taxes. This enhancement will include electronic data interchange (EDI) impacts.

What will change for trade users?

- A new accounting class code, 374, may be used by the trade community to request a refund of the Petroleum Superfund tax that was paid.
- New validations for Petroleum Superfund Drawback will be added to ACE (see ACE Drawback Error Dictionary v25).

What additional resources are available?

- Updated versions of the ACE Drawback Guidelines/CATAIR (v25) and the ACE Drawback Error Dictionary (v25) have been posted on CBP.gov at <https://www.cbp.gov/trade/ace/catair>. Both documents are currently in the “Draft Chapters: Future Capabilities” tab and later will be moved to the “Current Capabilities” and “Supporting Documents” tabs, respectively.
