


### Cargo Release and Entry Summary Filer Statistics


#### Cargo Release (CR)

- 76% (1,754 out of 2,318) of all CR filers who filed in March submitted via ACE, up from 60% in February. 243 first time filers.
- 1,824 CR filers have filed at least one time in ACE (or 79% based on average number of CR filers per month in FY15 of 2,319).




#### Entry Summary (ES)

- 88% (1,983 out of 2,265) of all ES filers in March submitted ACE ES, up from 82% in February. 55 first time filers.
- 2,110 ES filers have filed at least one time in ACE (or 88% based on average number of ES filers per month in FY15 of 2,402).




#### Deployment of Core Capabilities by Themes




#### Partner Government Agency (PGA) Pilots

#### ACE Submission Rates

$$\text{ACE Submission Rate} = \frac{\text{ACE Volume}}{\text{ACE Volume} + \text{ACS Total Volume}}$$



- ACE ES submission rate increased by five percent to reach 84%.
- ACE CR submission rate increased by 11% again from February to March to reach 42%.
- On April 1, ACE CR submission rate reached 61% for the day and ACE ES submission rate was 89%.

- The number of total unique ACE CRs in March increased by 120% from February, up from 68,197 to 150,110. APHIS Lacey and NHTSA led the way in growth from February to March:
  - APHIS Lacey +126%
  - NHTSA +145%
- The number of filers transmitting PGA message sets increased by 46% from last month, reaching 1,205.

#### ACE System Performance

The ACE Inherent Availability (Ai) is the time ACE is available for use excluding planned maintenance. The rolling 365 day ACE Ai for March was 97.3%
