**Discover a challenging and rewarding career with CBP's Air and Marine Operations (AMO), the nation's premier aviation and maritime law enforcement organization, responsible for detecting, intercepting and apprehending criminals at and beyond U.S. borders.** AMO is looking for Marine Interdiction Agents at the GL-1801-09 level to fill positions along the U.S. Southwest border, East Texas, Florida and the Caribbean. This position has an annual salary ranging from \$50,016.00 to \$64,534.00, and promotion potential to the GS-12 level.

## MAJOR DUTIES

- > Serves as an AMO vessel commander and crew member in law enforcement operations using CBP marine assets.
- > Conducts maritime patrols, surveillance and pursuit activities related to the interdiction of smuggled contraband via land, air and sea.
- > Conducts high-speed vessel pursuits and intercepts suspect vessels under adverse and sometimes hazardous conditions.
- > Searches vessels and/or persons to gather evidence to support allegations of criminal or terrorist activity.
- > Conducts investigations with federal, state and local law enforcement agencies concerning illegal maritime activity and potential acts of terrorism.

## KEY REQUIREMENTS

- > Be a U.S. citizen, pass a background security investigation and polygraph exam, have a valid state driver's license and have resided in the United States for at least the last three years.
- > Be under the age of 37, unless you are a qualified Veterans' Preference-eligible candidate.
- > Have one of the following Merchant Mariner Credentials: Master's License, Operator of Uninspected Passenger Vessels (OUPV) License or Deck's Mate License.
- > Be able to carry a firearm while performing duties.
- > Meet job-related medical, fitness and drug-testing standards.
- > Complete training programs including Spanish language instruction.
- > One year of law enforcement experience.
- > Successful completion of the vessel evaluation, oral and written exam.


