




Cargo Release and Entry Summary Filer Statistics


Cargo Release (CR)

- 81% (1,882 out of 2,312) of all CR filers who filed in April submitted via ACE, up from 76% in March. 181 first time filers.
- 2,005 CR filers have filed at least one time in ACE (or 86% based on average number of CR filers per month in FY15 of 2,319).




Entry Summary (ES)

- 95% (2,141 out of 2,262) of all ES filers in April submitted ACE ES, up from 88% in March. 148 first time filers.
- 2,258 ES filers have filed at least one time in ACE (or 94% based on average number of ES filers per month in FY15 of 2,402).



Deployment of Core Capabilities by Themes




Partner Government Agency (PGA)

- Among the current 12 available PGA Message Set programs, DDTC, DEA and FWS have yet to begin their pilots in production.
 - Vendors that will program for DEA and FWS are requesting additional implementation guidance.
- In accordance with the Trade Facilitation and Trade Enforcement Act, updates to two Chapter 98 provisions of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule (HTS) database were implemented late April.
- In mid-May, CBP will conduct a series of software vendor webinar to assist vendors with technical issues with PGA message set programs.
- Federal Register Notice for FDA must be published by May 13 in order to meet the proposed mandatory use date of June 15.

ACE Submission Rates

ACE Submission Rate =
(ACE Volume / ACE + ACS Total Volume)



- The ACE CR submission rate increased by 24% to reach 66% which the ACE ES submission rate climbed up to 94.5% for the month of April.
- Highest daily ACE CR% occurred on 4/27 with 77% and highest daily ACE ES% on 4/29 was 98%.
