



Alternative Funding Programs Donations Acceptance Program

Section 559 of the *Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014* (P.L. 113-76), authorizes the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Commissioner, in collaboration with the U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) Administrator, to conduct a five-year pilot program whereby CBP may enter into public and private partnerships for certain services and to accept certain donations. Partnerships entered into during such pilot program may last as long as required to meet the terms of such partnership.

Limitations & Other Considerations
Donations may not result in a new lease with CBP or GSA. Donations may not be accepted on foreign soil. Monetary donations may not be used for staffing.

Proposal Submission Options

Minimal Size, Scope, Complexity		Moderate to Significant Size, Scope, Complexity
May be submitted year-round		May be submitted during annual submission period (October timeframe)
