The sender should make certain the following information is put on the payment:

- 1. Company name
- 2. Company IRS number
- 3. An indication of what the payment is for:
 - a. Passenger User Fees for quarter and year
 - b. Railroad User Fees for month and year
 - c. Promissory Note number, bill number or audit finding, if applicable.

ACH CREDIT:

Automated Clearinghouse (ACH) credit is an electronic process that allows companies to transmit their payment directly to the U.S. Customs and Border Protection, without disclosing their company's bank account information. PAY.GOV:

Pay.gov is a secure internet payment platform provided by Financial Management Service (FMS) for payments to federal agencies through the use of ACH debit transactions.
