Limit of Parole of Nationals of the People's Republic of China into Guam and/or Commonwealth of Northern Mariana Islands

Beginning October 3, 2019, nationals from the People's Republic of China will be limited to not exceed 14 days under the discretionary parole policy to travel to Guam and/or Commonwealth of Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) for the purpose of temporary visit for business or pleasure without a visa.
