U.S. Customs and Border Protection, Office of Field Operations -Detroit Field Office will host the 9th Annual Trade Day via the Webex virtual platform on Tuesday, September 29, 2020 from 10 a.m. until 3:30 p.m.

This free event will provide the trade community and those interested in the importing/exporting process an opportunity to attend formal presentations from CBP subject matter experts representing the U.S. – Mexico – Canada Agreement (USMCA) Center, Customs Trade Partnership Against Terrorism (CTPAT), Automotive & Aerospace Center, Trade Policy & Programs, Cargo Security & Controls, and the Trade Transformation Office. The day will be organized into three 90-minute sessions consisting of two presentations each with scheduled breaks between sessions. Registered attendees will be able to attend all six unique presentations or only those presentations of interest.
