In one example, the attached image shows a migrant carrying a paralyzed subject out of the swift moving water on his back. Both were at risk of drowning had action not been taken by our agents.

**BLUF:** On October 26, 2023, at approximately 1930 hours (b)(7)(E) responded to a large group of migrants crossing the Rio Grande River near the (b)(7)(E) (b)(7)(E) area in (b)(7)(E) Texas.

- BPAs have rescued several migrants from the river and are providing medical attention.
- (b)(7)(E) Leadership is on scene and have relocated all migrants from the riverbank to a safer location.
- A CBP front end loader is being utilized to lift the concertina wire to provide aid to a paralyzed subject on the riverbank (see attachments).
- Three individuals are believed to have drowned (1-Adult female from FMUA, 2-Single Adults).
- BORSTAR has been activated and are responding.
- Approximately 40 subjects are on the riverbank and have yet to cross.
- FOB is engaging with Government of Mexico (GOM) to prevent the rest of the group from crossing.

Team,

Just got off a call with DRT Leadership regarding migrant encounters specifically (b)(7)(E). The State of Texas is mobilizing and will be placing (b)(7)(E) along the river in (b)(7)(E) like (b)(7)(E) in order to create a blockade in an attempt to prevent migrant crossings. That said, I think we all know how much more challenging it will be to conduct operations and rescue efforts given this week's events. Nonetheless, we will do what we can especially in emergency situations.

The below guidance regarding migrant encounters behind c-wire or connex boxes is now in effect.

- If we encounter migrants in distress that are behind the c-wire or connex boxes, take actions necessary to get through the impedance to provide first aid. Please ensure to get photographs of the incident and document in ESR/IIR.
- If we encounter migrants that are behind the c-wire or connex boxes who are not in distress or in any emergent situation, we will refrain from cutting through c-wire or moving connex boxes until we have approval from Sector.
  - This will need to be communicated through your COC on up to the PAIC/DPAIC. We will advise on the path forward once a decision is made.
  - Absent an emergency, supervisors and above should be the only agents cutting c-wire.
  - An ESR will need to be generated anytime we cut c-wire or move connex boxes regardless of group size.

This goes for everyone, myself included, it is important that we continue to remain professional even in the face of adversity. Please relay any situations or instances where you encounter State of Texas personnel who are being unprofessional and I will address.

We just got off a call with our Sector Leadership regarding our response to handling migrants on the river side of c-wire or connex boxes.

Updated Guidance;

If agents, migrants or anyone is in distress on the river side of c-wire or connex boxes, take action necessary to get through the impedance to provide first aid. Makes sure to get photographs of the incident and document in ESR/IIR.

If there are no migrants in distress or any emergency on the river side of the c-wire, we will refrain from cutting through c-wire until we have approval from Sector.

Notify your chain of command and we will route up and we will notify you once the decision is made.

Unless it is an emergency, supervisors and above should be the only agents cutting c-wire.

Anytime we do cut through the c-wire an IIR will be generated for documentation.

Continue to remain professional with our partners, ensure we are relaying that message to agents in muster.

If there is a disagreement let us know and (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) or I will handle it. Get names of anyone involved.

Team,

As we continue to deal with the influx of migrants attempting to make illegal entry and the deployment of resources from the State of Texas, there are a few things to keep in mind,

- If migrants have made landfall and made illegal entry beyond the concertina wire located at the river, we are required to respond and establish citizenship. If it is **not** an emergency, notify a supervisor and they will respond to cut the concertina wire and allow entry. If a supervisor is not available, you can cut the border fence or concertina wire to facilitate the ingress of the migrants to properly intake the subjects.
- If agents, migrants, or anyone are in distress or having a medical emergency, take action needed to get through the border fence and concertina wire to provide immediate first aid.
- Anytime we are required to cut the fence, notify a supervisor so they can make proper notifications.
- Continue to remain professional and courteous when dealing with other agencies. Notify a supervisor if you believe a misunderstanding is taking place between you and another Law Enforcement Agency while conducting your duties.

Texas DPS and partners are aware that we have an obligation to respond and take subjects into our custody. Once subjects are in our custody, we are not to turn them over to any other agency.

Bolt cutters and other tools are located inside the trailer at the (b)(7)(E) if the need arises to cut the fence.

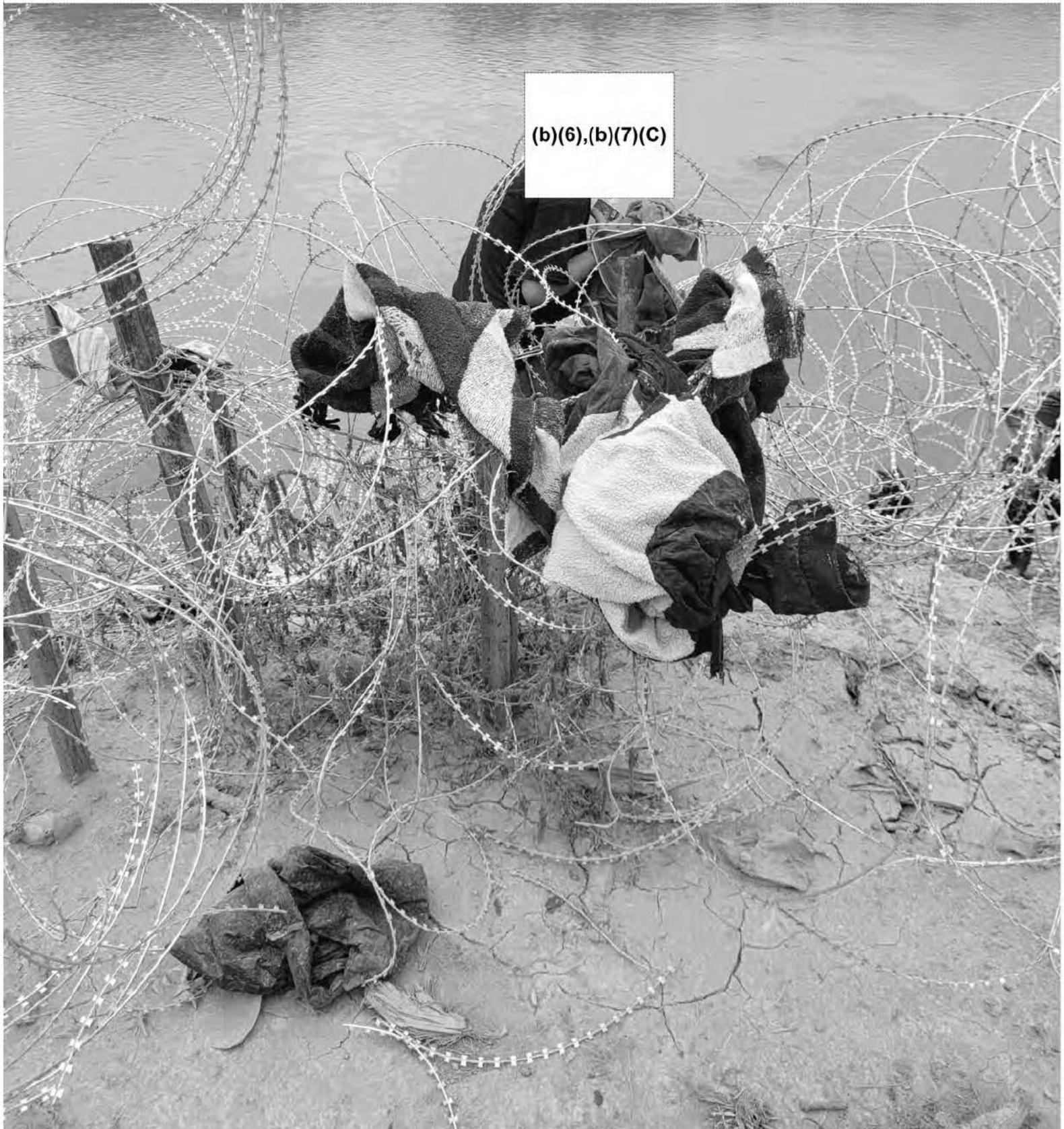

### SITUATION:

On October 10/29/2023 at around 1600hrs Duty Supervisor was notified by Texas National Guard of a group of 4 subjects in distress around the (b)(7)(E) area. Supervisor (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) and WC (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) responded and noticed that 3 of the subjects were able to cross C wire without any help or injury to themselves. A juvenile female subject was found to be on the riverside of the C-wire and unable to cross. Due to the subjects age and the area in which the subject crossed, WC (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) took the necessary step of cutting the C wire in order to prevent injury and safely allow the juvenile female to cross.
