

On **January 27, 2024**, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) will upgrade the Automated Commercial Environment (ACE) Reports application to run on SAP Business Objects (BO) 4.3. The upgrade to BO 4.3 involves changes to the ACE Reports user interface (UI).

What will change for trade users?

- Landing Page Change
 - When opening ACE Reports, users will no longer see the current homepage with the users' "Workspaces." Rather, a new landing page (Figure 1), titled "BI Launch Pad," will appear.
 - Users will access their available reports via the "Folders" tile.

- Additional tabs and tiles with other useful information will also be visible, including:
 - **Documents** this tile contains information on the specific reports available, including saved reports and the functions for scheduling reports.
 - Instances this tile lists specific instances of scheduled reports.

• Running Reports

- When getting started users will notice UI changes. However, BO 4.3 retains all the functions available to users in the previous version, and the underlying process steps remain the same for running reports.
 - One noteworthy improvement of the new platform is that data elements that are added to ad-hoc reports will automatically appear in the reports once they are run.

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Accessing ACE Reports

- To access ACE Reports, users need an ACE Secure Data Portal (ACE Portal) account. Users can apply for an account by following the steps outlined on the <u>Applying for an ACE</u> <u>Portal account webpage</u>.
