Advanced Export Information (AEI) Pilot Program

- Federal Register Notice published on January 31, 2014
- Allows exporters to submit only 10-12 data elements prior to departure
- Received applications from numerous exporters interested in participating
- Response letters were sent out at the beginning of August
- Allows exporters to submit only 10-12 data elements prior to departure

Advanced Export Information (AEI) Pilot Program

Mandatory AEI Data Elements

- (1) USPPI and USPPI identification
- (2) Ultimate consignee.
- (3) Commodity classification number.
- (4) Commodity description.
- (5) Port of export.
- (6) Date of export
- (7) Carrier identification.
- (8) Conveyance name/carrier name.
- (9) License code/license exemption code.
- (10) Shipment reference number.

Conditional AEI Data Elements

- (1) Authorized agent's identification number (if an authorized agent is used to prepare and file the EEI).
- (2) Export Control Classification Number (ECCN).

Advanced Export Information (AEI) Pilot Program

- Over 80 companies accepted into the pilot
- AES Data Elements
 - Filing Option Indicator: 3 = Advanced Export Information, partial of complete commodity shipment filing
 - AEI Filing Type:
 - P = Partial predeparture;
 - F = Full postdeparture
- Testing process moving into Production
- Next steps
