



## IMPORTANT UPDATE

### New Border Crossing Card Design

In late May 2014, the Department of State will introduce the new Border Crossing Card (also known as BCC or DSP-150). This new version (version 4) will be issued concurrently with the previous version BCC during a transition period of several months.

The BCC is issued to Mexican citizens who reside in Mexico. It can be used for air travel if accompanied by a valid passport.

This version of the BCC is valid in addition to the previous versions listed on page 49 in the Carrier Information Guide (May 2014 Update). The previous versions of the BCC are valid until expiration.
