


Cargo Release and Entry Summary Filer Statistics


Cargo Release (CR) – Total 3,144 Filers

- 47% (1,102 out of 2,321) of all CR filers who filed in January submitted via ACE, up from 36% in December.
- 230 filers filed ACE CR for the first time, bringing the total number of ACE CR filers filing at least one time to 1,331.




Entry Summary (ES) – Total 3,144 Filers

- 71% (1,712 out of 2,415) of all ES filers in January submitted ACE ES, up from 64% in December.
- 136 filers filed ACE ES for the first time this month, bringing the number of filers filing at least once in ACE to 1,883.




Deployment of Core Capabilities by Themes




Partner Government Agency (PGA) Pilots

As of January 31, a total 469 filers for 5,192 importers have participated in the nine pilot programs.



ACE Submission Rates

ACE Submission Rate =
(ACE Volume / ACE + ACS Total Volume)



- The ACE CR submission rate increased by nearly 7%, the largest percentage increase ever.
- The volume of ES filed in ACE decreased by 7% from December to January, while the volume of ES submitted in ACS increased by 1%.

- The number of unique filers jumped up from 114 in December to 469 in January. Rapid growth rate continues as we enter into mid-February.
- The number of cargo releases surpassed 30,000 in January and FDA accounted for approximately 80% of the volume.
- All vendors programming for FDA, NHTSA and APHIS Lacey have completed coding and testing, and are ready to pilot or currently piloting an entry in Production.

ACE System Performance

The ACE Inherent Availability (Ai) is the time ACE is available for use excluding planned maintenance. The January continuous 365 day Ai was 97.9%.
