
- Nine of 36 vendors remain to be certified for Cargo Release (CR) and five of them are currently testing.

Cargo Release and Entry Summary Filer Statistics

Cargo Release (CR) – Total 3,144 Filers


399 filers filed ACE CR at least one time since ACE inception.



- 77% (2,432 out of 3,144) of total filers are approved to file ACE cargo release.
- 14% (333 out of 2,341 filers this month) of all CR filers who filed in June submitted via ACE, up from 10% in May.
- 121 filers filed ACE CR for the first time this month, and 21 of those are among the top 200 for CR volume.
- 41% of the top 200 baseline filers have filed an ACE CR. The remaining 118 filers who have yet to file an ACE CR accounted for 24% of total CR volume in June.

Entry Summary (ES) – Total 3,144 Filers


1,323 filers filed ACE ES at least one time since ACE inception.



- 100% of all filers (3,144) are approved to file ACE ES.
- 50% (1,222 out of 2,420 filers this month) of all entry summary filers in June submitted ACE ES, up from 44% in May.
- 169 filers filed ACE entry summaries for the first time this month, and 8 of them were among the top 200 for ES volume.
- 86% of the top 200 baseline filers have filed an ACE ES. The remaining filers who have yet to file an ACE ES only account for 5% of total ES volume.


ACE Submission Rates

- Cargo release volume was 2.3% in June, dropping by 52% from May because of ACE air manifest performance issues. ACE entry summary volume increased by 14% from May.

Deployment of Core Capabilities by Themes
