




Cargo Release and Entry Summary Filer Statistics


Cargo Release (CR) – Total 3,144 Filers

- 26% (608 out of 2,318 filers this month) of all CR filers who filed in August submitted via ACE, up from 22% in August.
- 125 filers filed ACE CR for the first time, bringing the total number of ACE CR filers filing at least one time to 755.
- 124 of the top 200 baseline filers have filed at least one ACE CR. The remaining 76 filers account for 15% of total CR.



Entry Summary (ES) – Total 3,144 Filers

- 58% (1,403 out of 2,407 filers this month) of all ES filers in August submitted ACE ES, up from 57% in August.
- 57 filers filed ACE ES for the first time this month, bringing the number of filers filing at least once in ACE to 1,567.
- 183 of the top 200 baseline filers have filed at least one time and they accounted for 79% of total ES (ACE + ACS) volume in September.
- 566 filers filed more than 95% of their ES in ACE, and 50 are among the top 200 baseline filers.



Partner Government Agency (PGA) Pilots


Message Set Pilots

- 12 filers participated in the pilots in September.
- Multiple filers have independently filed APHIS (Lacey), FDA and NHTSA entries.
- Development teams are actively addressing issues as they are found.
- In early October, two filers successfully filed FDA entries with Prior Notice (PN). FDA is planning to expand the PN pilot to additional participants.

Export Pilots


- Since January 2015, there have been more than 3,500 successful filings as part of a Hazardous Waste Exports pilot with EPA.
- Beta testing with a limited group of trade filers was initiated to begin usage of ACE AESDirect capabilities. After less than one week, over 45 successful filings have been received.

ACE Submission Rates



- ACE ES submission rate for September rose 2.3% to 66.8%.
- ACE CR submission rate grew from 4.5% in August to 8.3% in September.

Deployment of Core Capabilities by Themes



- Prior Notice capability was deployed on September 19.
- Remaining capabilities scheduled for FY16 deployment include: multiple holds, expedited release, additional entry and entry summary types, FTZ admissions and remaining post release capabilities.
