



Summary of ACE/ITDS Pilot Standard Operating Procedures (SOP): Animal Plant Health Inspection Service Lacey Act (Lacey)

Objective: Lacey is transitioning from getting their data through ACS to developing a PGA message set and processes in ACE. The Lacey Act Web Governance System (LAWGS) will still remain a method to file. In order to test the developed message set and processes CBP and Lacey will engage, together with the trade community, in piloting the new system in real time with actual ACE filings in the production environment. All Lacey commodities will be available for testing.

Ports (Phases 1, 2, 3, & 4): Lacey’s deployment of additional ports and filers in phases 2, 3 and 4 will depend on the results of phase 1, the readiness of those firms who have replied to the Lacey and the preparedness of to conduct electronic filings through ACE.
