## Riverine Class 25-Foot SAFE Boat

# FACT SHEET



U.S. Customs and Border Protection, U.S. Border Patrol utilizes the 25-foot Secure-Around-Flotation-Equipped (SAFE) Boat for maritime operations.

The 25-foot SAFE Boat is an aluminum hulled, foam-collared vessel capable of operating in the shallow water of the riverine (rivers and lakes) environment. It has a fully-enclosed, protected cabin that makes it ideal for operation during inclement weather.

It is an integral part of the riverine patrol fleet, whose purpose is to stop maritime smuggling into the United States. The 25-foot SAFE Boat provides an excellent enforcement platform to detect and apprehend illegal aliens and drug smugglers attempting to enter the United States by way of shallow water rivers and lakes.

Two Border Patrol agents work in conjunction with the Office of Air and Marine, Department of Homeland Security, Department of Defense and other federal, state and local law enforcement agencies to combat maritime smuggling and protect U.S. ports from acts of terrorism.
