Interceptor Class 42-Foot Invincible

FACT SHEET



Marine interdiction agents (MIAs) with CBP's Air and Marine Operations (AMO) use the 42-foot Interceptor Class Invincible to conduct maritime enforcement operations.

The crew operates in the littoral and offshore waters of the United States and its territories in varying sea and weather conditions. The vessel provides agents with a safe, working platform to perform their duties and missions.

The vessel's significant freeboard enables a comfortable dry ride with increased visibility. The vessel's powerful 4-stroke engines make it capable of performing high speed maneuvers in close proximity to other vessels, which enables agents to perform successful, high-risk pursuit and intercept missions.

The Invincible 3-person (minimum) crew work together with AMO aviation assets and other federal, state and local law enforcement entities to accomplish the homeland security mission.
