

OTHER BOND TYPES

Activity Code Types 14, 15, and 17

Below are brief descriptions of Activity Code Types 14, 15, and 17, which currently cannot be used on the CBP Form 301 (Customs Bond).

Type 14: *In-Bond Export Consolidation (IBEC) Bond*

- Required in the South Florida Customs Management Center, per Information Bulletin No. 99-013
- Attached samples include: An IBEC Bond, Address Change Rider, and Name Change Rider.

Type 15: *Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)*

- This is a continuous bond when samples are furnished for Trademark, Trade name or Copyright suspected violations occur

- Completed Samples include: An IPR Bond, Address Change Rider, Name Change Rider, and Addendum Rider
- Template Sample provided.

Type 17: *Marine Terminal Operator Bond*

- Continuous Bond Only
- Use when the Terminal Operator does not have an Activity Code Type 3 (International Carrier) on file
- Minimum bond amount is fixed at \$100,000, not to exceed \$500,000

- Completed Samples include: A Terminal Operator Bond, Address Change Rider, and Name Change Rider.
