INTERNATIONAL TRADE

- In FY2013, U.S. trade accounted for \$2.4 trillion in imported goods and \$1.6 trillion in exported goods

ACE / ITDS

- Executive Order establishes deadline of December 2016 for implementation
- ACE is the technology enabler through which Single Window processing will be achieved
- Key features to enable Single Window processing have been implemented

- Largely paper-based with multiple entry systems

December 22, 2010 - ATTENTION ALL ACE PORTAL USERS: On November 15, 2010, U.S. Customs and Border Protection posted a message to the ACE Portal News tab indicating that importers were receiving an error message when attempting to respond to a CBP Forms 28, 29 and 4647 through the ACE Portal. That issue has now been resolved for ACE filed entry summaries. Trade will no longer receive the Team Management error when responding to CBP forms through the ACE Portal for ACE filed entry summaries. There is still an issue with trade responding to CBP forms through the portal for ACS filed entry summaries. CBP is making every effort to resolve this issue as quickly as possible. Until the issue is resolved, importers and brokers are reminded to respond to CBP forms for ACS filed entry summaries by U.S. mail. CBP will update the ACE Portal News tab when the new issue is resolved.

November 23, 2010 - ATTENTION IMPORTERS AND BROKERS: U.S. Customs and Border Protection is aware that when ESM 7025, CBP Forms 28, 29, 4647 Status Report, is run the report is only returning results for forms issued for ACE filed entry summaries. To view forms issued for both ACE and ACS filed entry summaries, users need to run the report under "Modify" and then select "Cancel" and "Edit Query" to remove the "System Control Code" object from the "Query Filters." Remember to save the report to the "Favorites" folder for future use.

November 15, 2010 - ATTENTION ALL ACE PORTAL USERS: U.S. Customs and Border Protection is aware that importers are receiving an error message when attempting to respond to CBP Forms 28, 29 and 4647 through the ACE Portal. CBP is making every effort to resolve this issue and quickly as possible. Until the issue is resolved and portal functionality is restored, importers and brokers are reminded to respond to CBP forms by U.S. mail. CBP will update the ACE Portal News tab when the issue is resolved.

October 31, 2010 - ATTENTION ALL ACE PORTAL USERS: On October 31, 2010 U.S. Customs and Border Protection successfully deployed enhanced ACE capabilities related to Entry Summary, Accounts and Revenue (ESAR). This release provides enhancements to portal capabilities for CBP as well as the redesign of the Entry Summary Universe for all users running reports on ACE filed entry summaries.

October 13, 2010: ATTENTION ALL ACE REPORT USERS: Effective October 13, 2010, U.S. Customs & Border Protection will be reducing the number of saved occurrences of reports visible when selecting the "History" link for reports saved under "My Folders". Users will only be able to view the last 10 historical instances of the saved report. In addition, any historical instance of the saved report that is older than 1 year will also be removed regardless if there are less than 10 historical instances.





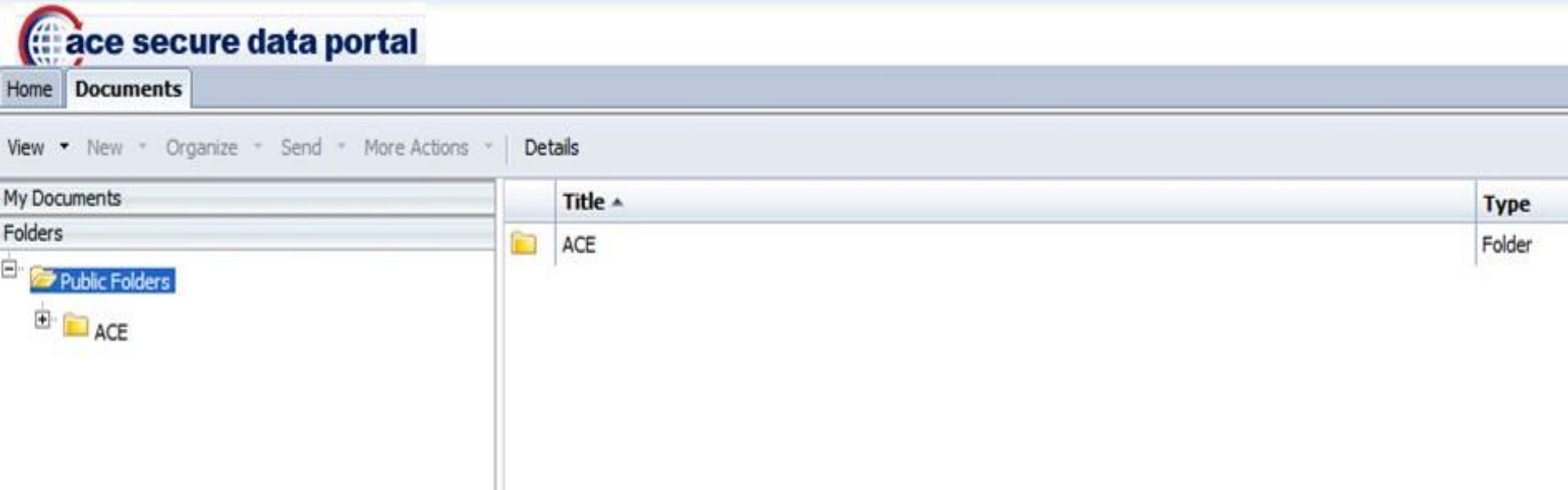
