

QB 14 – 128 Textile Unit of Measure
Visa Reporting Quantity



EXPLANATION OF VISA REPORTING QUANTITY

COMMODITY

Textiles – Unit of measure to report on visa.

The visa unit of measure shall be reported via the first unit of quantity in the Harmonized Tariff Schedule (HTS) or the underlined HTS. For example: HTS 6111.30.1000 requires kg in the visa.

SECTION XI

TEXTILES AND TEXTILE ARTICLES

From the HTS Statistical Note: XI-9, highlighted in yellow.

- The unit of measure to be used by Customs field offices when reporting imports of textiles to Customs Headquarters Quota Section shall be the first unit of quantity unless the second unit of quantity (if there is one) is underlined, in which case the second unit of quantity shall be reported.
