



The U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Automated Commercial Environment (ACE) Secure Data Portal is a web-based capability providing a single, centralized on-line access point to connect CBP, the trade community and government agencies involved in importing goods into the United States. The portal provides information with which more than 20,000 trade account holders can identify and evaluate compliance issues and monitor daily operations. ACE allows users to access the reports tool, compile data and perform national trend analysis.

### ACE Reports Features

- ACE portal users have access to more than 125 standard reports on company-specific compliance, transaction and financial data from both ACE and the Automated Commercial System.
- Users can customize and design reports to fit individual business needs. User-friendly features include:
  - Sorting, adding or removal of data;
  - Creation of custom charts and graphs; and
  - Saving of personalized or uniquely formatted reports as templates for data retrieval
- Users can schedule reports to run automatically, at the date, time and frequency of their choosing.
- Users gain greater flexibility through authorized data extracts that allow for download of large sums of account data and import into a local reporting system.
- Users can share customized reports with all users within the account who have access to reports

### ACE Reports Benefits

Through ACE, users can improve their compliance with trade laws by running targeted reports to conduct in-house audits, to identify systemic errors and to provide insight into entries under review by CBP. Access to the ACE reports tool allows users to:

- Identify unauthorized filers;
- Proactively monitor trade compliance and identify discrepancies;
- Monitor periodic monthly statements as they are being built;
- Monitor carrier activity by driver, conveyance or equipment.
- Monitor rail and sea in-bond movements, bills of lading, manifest and equipment data.



### Types of Reports:

**Account Management Reports** - include aggregate and detail cargo entry and entry summary reports for ACS and ACE filed summaries, compliance reports, etc.

**Account Revenue Reports** - include reports for entry summaries flagged for inclusion on a periodic daily or monthly statement.

**Authorized Data Extract Reports** - include extract reports that can be scheduled to run with up to 2,000,000 rows of data provided.

**Entry Summary Reports** – include reports filed for ACE Entry Summaries with the exception of the CBP Form 28, 29, 4647 which includes both ACE and ACS filed summaries.

**Multi-Modal Manifest Reports** – includes bill of lading reports, in-bond reports, manifest and equipment reports.

**Reference Reports** – include the Public FIRMS code report and the UN Location Code report.

**Transaction Reports** - include truck manifest reports including BRASS reports, carrier activity, in-bond and compliance reports as well as transactions details reports.

### Near Real-Time Access to Data

- CBP updates Account Revenue reports hourly;
- CBP updates Multi-Modal Manifest reports in the Trade Reporting folder every two hours
- CBP updates compliance data monthly.
- CBP updates all other report data nightly
