Description of Change:	<p>CBP is currently planning for a Simplified Entry process that would allow qualified importers who meet specified criteria to file 12 elements that will serve as both the ISF filing and the cargo entry. The existing Aggregate and Detail Cargo Entry reports need to be modified to include <b>all</b> of the data elements from the simplified entry (whatever the final number of data elements is) that are not currently available in the existing Cargo Entry reports, such as Shipper Name and Address, Buyer Name and Address, Bill of Lading or Air Waybill Number, etc. In addition a new field (indicator) needs to be added to the Aggregate and Detail Cargo Entry reports reflecting the fact that this is a Simplified Entry filing. This should eliminate confusion on why all data elements in the report are not populated with information.</p> <p>AD-003, Cargo Entry Report extract would need to be updated as well to include all data elements from the simplified entry as well as an indicator reflecting the fact that this is a Simplified Entry filing.</p>

	Should CBP create a new report that just includes Simplified Entries, the trade community requests access to that report as well and recommends the following filters be available when the report is run: Importer of Record Number, Entry Number, Bill of Lading Number/House Air Waybill Number, Port of Entry and Cargo Entry Date Range
<b>Benefit of Change:</b>	Allow trade to view in one report all cargo entries filed as well as monitor filings under the Simplified Entry process.
