


# AUTOMATED COMMERCIAL ENVIRONMENT – DEPLOYMENT B

## NEW ACE FEATURES

By the end of 2016, ACE will become the Single Window, the primary system through which the international trade community will submit data and documentation required by all Federal agencies for imports and exports and the government will determine their admissibility.



January 4, 2014 marks the second deployment of new ACE features. These capabilities expand all areas of ACE cargo processing, and bring the Government one step closer to a true Single Window environment for electronic trade processing.

## ACE DEPLOYMENT B FEATURES

### CARGO RELEASE

New ACE Cargo Release capabilities expand to more modes of transportation and bring CBP closer to full cargo release processing in ACE

#### NEW FEATURES INCLUDE:

- Expands ACE Cargo Release pilot to include foundational capabilities for ocean and rail manifest shipments.
- Enables partial quantities for Cargo Release with in-bond movements, initially for air shipments.
- Creates a single accept/reject message, so that filers only receive one message that includes both CBP and PGA actions.
- Incorporates the Mail Entry Writing System (MEWS) into ACE which enables more effective tracking and collection of the duties/fees owed for imported items that are delivered by the U.S. Postal Service. This feature will enable the collection of more than \$2 million a year in previously uncollected duties/fees.

### ENTRY SUMMARY

Entry Summary Validations for Duty Calculations increase the integrity of data submitted to CBP

- Enables ACE to verify duty calculations submitted by filers when there is one Harmonized Tariff Schedule (HTS) classification per Entry Summary line.

### MANIFEST

Integration of Vessel Management System (VMS) capabilities in ACE provides a modernized tool for CBP personnel to facilitate trade and protect the borders

- Allows CBP officers to more quickly and efficiently monitor and manage the thousands of vessels that pass through U.S. ports each day.

### PGA INTEGRATION

Modernized tools increase interagency collaboration and new enhancements reduce data duplication for filers

- Enhances the way PGA Message Set data is submitted to greatly reduce data duplication for the trade filer.
- Upgrades screens to streamline the reporting of findings for CBP Agriculture Specialists.
