

New ACE Features

By 2016 ACE will become the Single Window for trade processing

Deployed July 12, 2014


- **Cargo Release** - Capabilities that allow a Unified Cargo Release and Importer Security Filing have been incorporated into the ACE Cargo Release Pilot.
- **Expanded Entry Summary Validations** - New validations for informal entry restrictions, charges restrictions, other fees, and taxes are active in ACE.

Coming October 18, 2014

- **Exports** - Electronic air export manifest capabilities will be available in ACE, allowing for electronic filing of export manifests in the air mode as opposed to paper.
- **New PGA Message Set Pilots** - Two new PGA Message Set pilots will be initiated with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The pilots will cover filings for hazardous waste exports and pesticides, vehicles and engines imports.

Coming January 3, 2015

- **Manifest** - Electronic import air manifest filings will be implemented; electronic import manifests for all modes of transportation will now be processed in ACE.
- **Cargo Release** - Cargo release filings in the truck mode, including in-bonds and certified from summary, as well as non-ABI processing, will be incorporated into the ACE Cargo Release pilot.
- **Entry Summary** - Capability to file entry types 21, 22, 31, and 34 will be included in ACE.
- **E-Bond** - Electronic filing and processing of Single Transaction Bonds and Continuous Bond capabilities will be in ACE.
- **Exports** - Add an option to file ocean and rail manifests electronically in lieu of paper.



Recent Capabilities Implemented November 2013 - April 2014

Cargo Release

The ACE Cargo Release pilot was expanded to include electronic corrections and cancellations in all modes; ability to certify entry data from entry summary transactions in air, ocean, and rail modes; ability to process in-bond shipments and partial shipments in air, ocean, and rail modes; ability to process split shipments in the air mode; and basic processing in the truck mode.

Entry Summary

Validations were expanded to include Harbor Maintenance Fee, Tariff Classification, Simple and Complex Duty Calculations, and Merchandise Processing Fee.

Exports

Exports processing was migrated to the ACE platform.
